

National Cyber Security Agenda

The Netherlands is in an outstanding position to capitalize on the economic and social opportunities of digitalisation. At the same time, vulnerabilities and threats in the digital domain are increasing. These developments call for an increased effort to strengthen the approach to cybersecurity and thereby better protect the vital interests of the Netherlands. The National Cyber Security Agenda (NCSA) sets out the framework for the next step required in cybersecurity.

The NCSA comprises seven ambitions that contribute towards the following objective:

The Netherlands is capable of capitalizing on the economic and social opportunities of digitalisation in a secure way and of protecting national security in the digital domain.

These seven ambitions have been elaborated into objectives and measures that will be implemented in close public-private cooperation.
